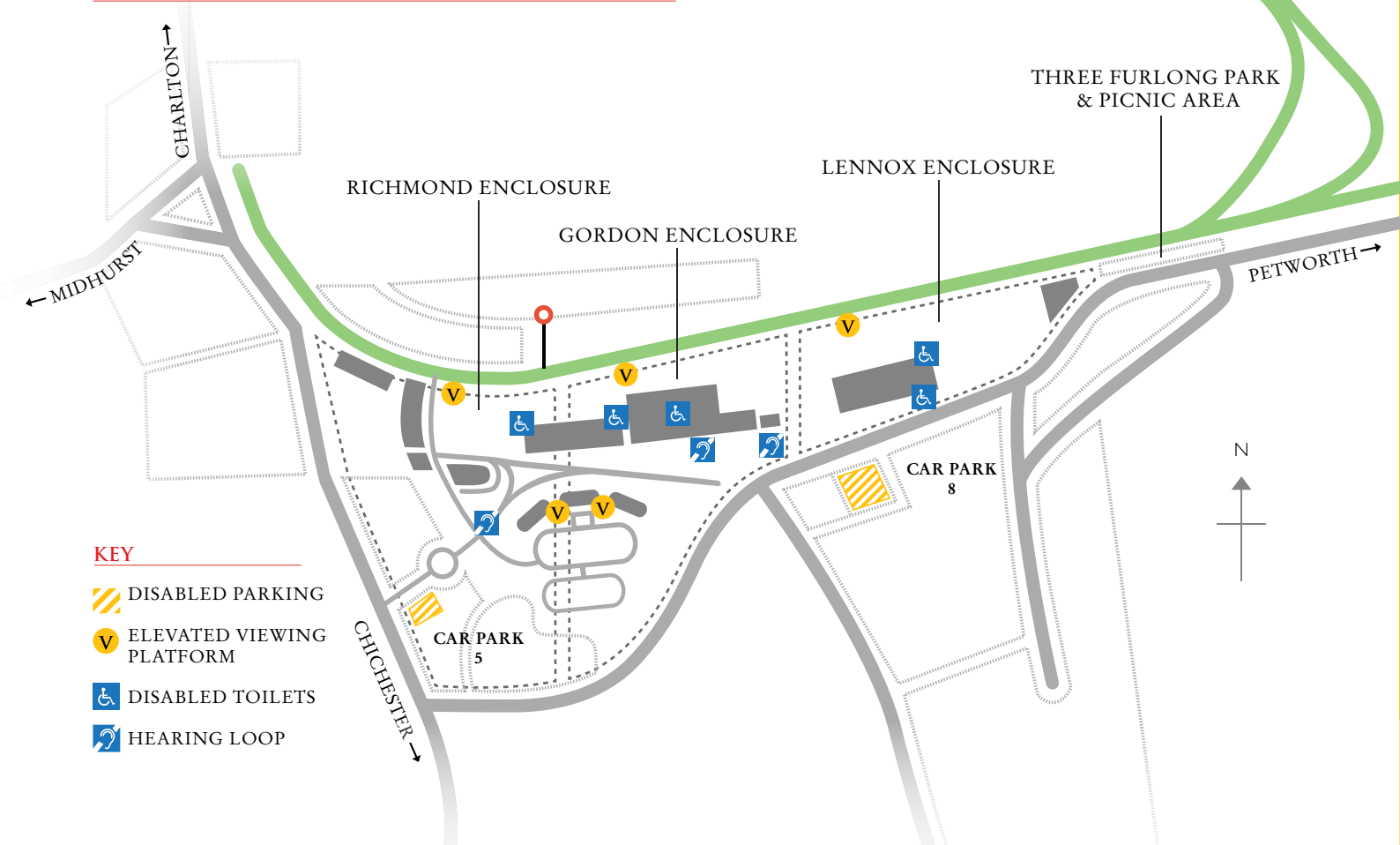






RACECOURSE MAP

ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

Goodwood Racecourse is firmly committed to giving all guests the very best possible experience when they come racing. This leaflet has been designed to provide all the information you need to make the most of your visit.

PARKING

Complimentary Blue Badge parking spaces are available close to the Racecourse entrances at the front of Car Park 5 and 8 for vehicles displaying a valid badge. Blue Badge parking is operated on a first come, first served basis on the day. A complimentary mobility shuttle buggy service, with bespoke wheelchair access, will be in operation within Car Park 8 and 9. This shuttle will offer service from your vehicle to the nearest available hardstanding and will be in operation upon entry and exit to the event.

EVENT MOBILITY

There are five non-electric wheelchairs which can be booked in advance, free of charge, by calling 01243 755022. If you are arriving by taxi or bus, you will

be directed to the Transport Terminus which is located close to our East Entrance. Please ask the stewards if you need assistance or directions on arrival.

VIEWING – PARADE RING

Viewing of the Parade Ring is easily accessible from ramps either side of the central Parade Ring bar. These ramps allow for elevated viewing of the Parade Ring, with a smaller designated viewing area on the top level. The ramps continue to the Winners' Enclosure for low-level viewing.

VIEWING – TRACK

There are three dedicated disabled viewing platforms located on the rails by the track. The Richmond platform is located in front of the Richmond Lawn, the Gordon platform is located in front of the Sussex Stand and the Lennox platform is located on the Gordon / Lennox dividing fence. Wheelchair users in the Richmond Enclosure are also welcome to use the covered viewing area on the first floor March Stand balcony. The lift can be accessed at the south side of the March Stand through the main glass doors, adjacent to the main stairwell. Wheelchair users in the Gordon Enclosure may use the

covered viewing area on the second floor Sussex Roof Terrace. The lift can be accessed at the south side of the Sussex Grandstand via the brick ramp into the lift lobby. The front row of the covered seating in the Sussex Roof Terrace is reserved for priority seating and has space for wheelchair users.

ACCESSIBLE TABLES

There are a number of accessible tables located near the track by the Gordon / Lennox dividing fence. These can be pre-booked on a first come first served basis by calling 01243 755022. Wristbands will be issued to the person with accessible needs, plus one companion.

TRIPS TO THE START

If you would like to join us on one of our trips to the start, the bus leaves approximately ½ hour before the second, fourth and sixth races (day racing) and second and fourth races (evening racing) from the Transport Terminus, over the road from the East Entrance. Unfortunately, the ground is not suitable for wheelchairs.

TOILETS

Disabled toilets are located within each enclosure.

All disabled toilets are operated by radar key which are kept at Racecourse Reception, First Aid points and the March Stand cloakroom.

ASSISTANCE DOGS

Guide dogs and official assistance dogs are welcome at the Racecourse by advance request. See Event Dog Form **here**.

HEARING LOOPS

These are located at our two main East and West Entrances.
